To enter this show, you must complete the following steps. Entries that are late are always considered but most of the time they will be hung at a later date after the show has opened.

- 1. Fill out the entry form on the next page.
- 2. Email that form PLUS photos of what you want to enter by **Monday, June 24**. jane@CanterburyCountryStore.com
- 3. OR bring in the filled out form with <u>photos</u> to the store. DO NOT BRING WORK IN AT THIS POINT.
- 4. Wait to hear back from Jane by email if all of your work was accepted. Sometimes we do not have enough space for everything or the items may not fit the theme of the show.
- 5. After you have heard which of your work is accepted, bring it in **Monday, July 1 with the drop off sheet** during store hours 7am-6pm. Jane will have already made the title cards so we can hang your work immediately. The show is hung the day work is dropped off.
 - Late delivery for accepted work means that your work will not be hung immediately but at a later date when space is created for it.
 - Late entries—if accepted—will not have the title cards yet so their hanging will be delayed also.
 - If you are not available to drop off on April 8 contact Jane to make arrangements for an alternative day/time.
- 6. We encourage you to come anytime during this show to linger around your work to answer questions and meet viewers. Due to our tight space, a reception will not be held.
- 7. Pick up any work that has not sold on Monday, September 9 or by special app't.

- You MUST write the name of the work on the back of each item.
- You may enter up to 3 artworks. Depending on space available in the Loft and if the work does not fit the theme requirements below, we may not be able to accept all you have entered.
- So that all of your work looks good together the theme requirements are:
 - 1. Must be an actual flag/banner but may be a rendering of a flag or include a flag in an over-all picture. May include wording or statements but controversial language will not be allowed.
 - 2. Any medium is acceptable; paper, wood, canvas, fabric, plastic...
 - 3. Size limit is 18" x 36". 3D accepted space allowing.
 - 4. Must include the color red somewhere in your piece.

To be fair to everyone, if your work does not contain these elements it will not be considered.
